ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Language of instruction: English or German
Important: Faculties 1 and 2 offer English-taught courses in winter only; summer exchange is not possible!

Credit system: ECTS (up to 30 per semester)

Course selection and Learning Agreement:

- Learning Agreements via EWP or form, coordinated with the home institution.

Transcript of Records:

- Issued within 4 weeks after the end of the mobility period.

German language course:

- Intensive course during Welcome Weeks; weekly course during the semester.
- ECTS credits awarded (subject to home institution approval).

SEMESTER CONTRIBUTION

- Covers student services, semester ticket (public transportation) and student body.

ACCOMMODATION

- Exchange students may apply for a room in a student dormitory provided by Studentenwerk Hannover (see overview [here](#)).
- After acceptance, the Incoming Team will contact students and inform them how to apply.
- Other housing options are also available in Hannover, such as private dormitories or sublets in shared flats.

VISA / HEALTH INSURANCE

EU students:

- Valid ID card/passport; a valid European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) is required for enrolment.

Non-EU students:

- Valid health insurance required for enrolment (statutory health insurance recommended).
